Act 3, Preamble Section 18.E. directs the Commissioner of Administration to allocate appropriations upon the approval of an employee compensation plan by the Civil Service Commission and the governor. A preamble adjustment of \$816,257 [State General Fund (Direct)] to this budget unit is included in the numbers above.

Act 3, Higher Education Preamble Section directs the Board of Regents to provide for a distribution of State General Fund (Direct) to all higher education agencies. This distribution is included in the numbers above.

Act 293 grants authority to the public postsecondary education management boards to establish fees and adjust fee amounts at institutions under their respective management and supervision for FY2016 through FY2020. These established or adjusted fees are included in the numbers above.
