- Valid, unexpired passport (at least six months remaining)
- Valid, unexpired entry visa (unless exempt)
- I-20 with travel signature less than one year old on the date you return (signed on page 2)
- Evidence of financial resources (pay checks stubs or bank statement) Students who receive a stipend from LSUHSC can get employment verification using the Work Number system.
- Current tuition receipts and transcript to confirm your full-time enrollment. Please contact the Registrar's Office for a copy of your transcript.
- Name and contact information for the school's Designated School Official (DSO):

When you return to the U.S., make sure that the I-94 issued to you is properly marked as $\underline{F-1 D/S}$

If you are enrolled in a Trusted Traveler Program such as Global Entry or Nexus, be sure NOT to use it when going through immigration processing when entering/re-entering the United States. Doing so will automatically admit you in B1/B2 status, which does not permit full time study or employment. Use the documents issued for your specific immigration status, such as I-20, DS-2019, I-797, etc.

Please provide a copy of the newly issued I-94 and any other newly issued documents (*entry visa*, *passport*, *etc.*) to the International Services office immediately when you return.
