## Auxiliary Enterprise Balances as of June 30, 2004

## LSU Health Sciences Center, New Orleans

Auxiliary Enterprises on the New Orleans Campus have an overall cash balance of \$6.3 million as of June 30, 2003. This represents a significant increase from June 30, 2003. The increase is due to the following:

- Accounts receivable decreased \$1.7 million. Our primary outside customers are the HCSD and Pennington Biomedical Center. The decrease is due to improved collections and timing differences between fiscal years.
- Inventories decreased by \$23,951.
- Revenues exceeded expense by over \$350,000.

Projected uses of cash balances include:

- 1. Increased and improved parking space for faculty, students and staff by utilizing newly acquired land or leased space. Improvements include fencing and surface work.
- 2. The revenues of all the auxiliary enterprises are pledged to support the retirement of revenue bond indebtedness for the Charity Nursing dorm project.
