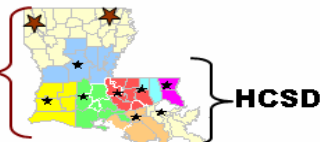
- A SAFETY - NET SYSTEM FOR OUR STATE -

LSU operates ten public hospitals, of which eight are managed by the Health Care Services Division. Combined, the LSU facilities admit 81,000 patients annually, and they provide nearly 2 million outpatient visits, around 70 percent of which are clinic visits.

The LSU Hospitals and Clinics

- **Mission-driven to care for the uninsured and provide training opportunities for future health professionals**
- **A statewide Safety Net system in which everyone is eligible for care**
 - No income thresholds
 - No local residency requirements
 - No enrollment process
 - People with means expected to pay
- **Provide comprehensive inpatient, outpatient hospital and clinic services**
 - 350+ clinics
 - Relies on medical residents for a substantial component of physician care as part of GME training programs
