

## **Module 3 - Outline (Physical Activity)** (Citation and Bibliography Module)

### **RefWorks – Web-based bibliography and database manager**

- Create a personal database by importing references from text files or online databases.
- Organize your references into folders according to topics of interest or particular assignments or projects.
- Utilize these references in writing papers and automatically formatting the bibliography (Write-N-Cite).
  - Insert references into the body of your research paper, and generate formatted references pages.

### **SCOPUS – abstract and citation database of research literature and quality web sources**

- Displays and links to cited references.
- Export selected citations directly to RefWorks.
  - Initial setup required

### **Web of Science via Web of Knowledge – abstract and citation database of published journal articles and paper and poster abstracts from conferences.**

- Contains EndNote Web (like RefWorks)
- Direct export to RefWorks.
  - Search and save records directly to a personal online library.
    - Either RefWorks or EndNote Web
- Collect and organize references and format citations and footnotes for a bibliography. (RefWorks or EndNote Web)

### **Citing Medicine**

**The NLM Style Guide for Authors, Editors, and Publishers** Provides assistance to authors in compiling lists of references for their publications.
