- President's Report: Senator Spieler reported on the Executive Committee with Dr. Moerschbaecher/Executive Committee on Thursday, January 4th.
 - The IT department is currently organized in a decentralized structure where each school/division has assigned IT staff who are able to support the unique technological needs of each school/division. The subject of IT department decentralization vs. centralization was discussed at the Executive Committee meeting, and Senator Spieler agreed to bring this topic to the Senate for their feedback and a possible resolution. Feedback from the Senate was in favor of maintaining the current decentralized structure. As there was no opposition, President Spieler will draft a resolution voicing the Senate's support for the current, decentralized structure.
