Be it resolved that the Faculty Senate of LSUHSC-NO, on behalf of the faculty, unanimously support the efforts of Chancellor Hollier, President Lombardi, and the LSU Board of Supervisors to gain approval to build and take leadership in operating a modern LSU hospital in which we can effectively and efficiently educate future healthcare professionals in our State, perform research to advance healthcare practices, and deliver the best healthcare to the citizens of Louisiana.
