

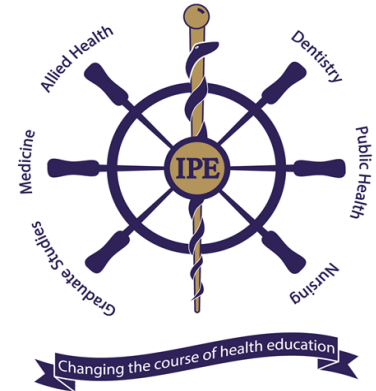


LSU Health New Orleans

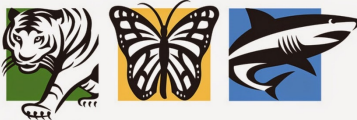

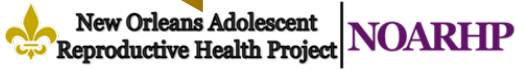
