Identification

Foreign passport with I-94, showing status with USCIS

You must have 180 days (6 months) left on your status to be issued a driver's license, as indicated by the end date on your I-20, DS-2019, Employment Authorization Document (EAD) or I-797 Approval Notice**.

Students and Exchange visitors will **NOT be issued a license with validity that includes the 60 or 30 grace period permitted at the end of their educational/exchange program.**

F-1 Students with a pending application for Post Completion OPT cannot obtain a driver's license renewal until their OPT has been approved and the EAD card is received. F-1 Students in a cap gap extension period cannot obtain a license renewal until the H1B petition has been approved , the I-797 Approval Notice is received and the start date has arrived.

H1B and TN employees and their dependents cannot obtain a driver's license renewal during the 240 day grace period permitted while an **extension request is pending. The I-797 Approval Notice must be received before the license can be renewed.**

Social Security Verification

Social Security Card /Number OR a letter from Social Security Administration stating the applicant is not eligible for a social security card/number. Most dependents are not eligible for a social security number and it is not necessary to obtain a letter of ineligibility for these dependents. J-2 dependents are eligible for employment through approved work authorization and may require an ineligibility letter from the Social Security Office.

Out of Country License

If out of country license is **not** from Germany or Switzerland, the applicant must complete a 6-hour pre-licensing course from an approved driving school. The road stills and computerized testing will also be conducted by the driving school. If the Out of Country license does not already include English translation of a foreign language, a translation will be required. There are many options for obtaining a translation. (A current list of schools is available at <u>www.expresslane.org</u>)

Out of State License

If you have a valid license from another U.S. State, you may surrender that license and obtain a Louisiana license. Applicants surrendering a valid out of state license will be exempted from all testing, except the vision screening.

The student's name must agree in all documents

Procedures

All applicants must pass a vision test (20/40 minimal acceptable vision)

All applicants must pass the: Road Signs Test (25 questions)	80% passing	You may use an English translation dictionary. You must present the dictionary before the test is begun.

The applicant must furnish the vehicle. If the applicant does not own a vehicle, they may borrow one from a friend. The applicant should be familiar with the vehicle (Drive it before going to the office. Be familiar with the vehicle and its equipment; lights, horn, blinkers, etc.)

The vehicle must have:
Current registration and license plate
Current liability insurance

Current inspection sticker

The applicant must successfully complete basic driving maneuvers following the instructions given by the Motor Vehicle employee.

Current school ID card and current fee bill showing paid in

full. If the money is being transferred to the school and the

student does not have the fee bill, a letter from the Bursar is

needed to verify current enrollment (Dependents must be

accompanied by the student and their ID documents)
