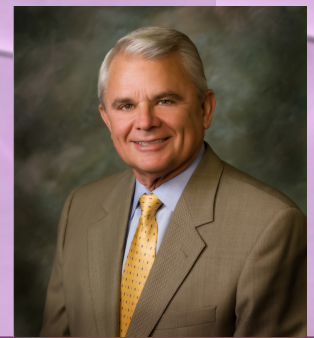

Dr. August Ochoa has been named to the Board of Scientific Counselors for the National Cancer Institute, in Clinical Sciences and Epidemiology. He will serve a four-year term.

Appointed by the Director of the NCI, the purpose of the Board is to provide scientific advice and review of the progress of the intramural clinical and epidemiological research programs of the NCI Center for Cancer Research (CCR) and the Division of Cancer Epidemiology and Genetics (DCEG). The Board advises the Directors of CCR and DCEG, and the Director and Deputy Director of the NCI, on a wide variety of matters concerning scientific program policy and progress and future direction of research programs.

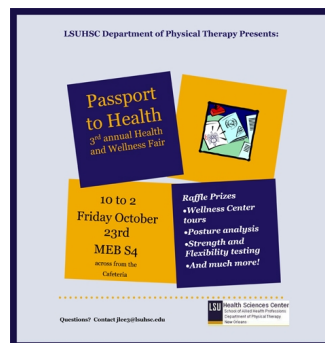
replacing damaged and depleted play therapy toys for our outpatient clinic and sound screens for greater privacy during therapy sessions.
