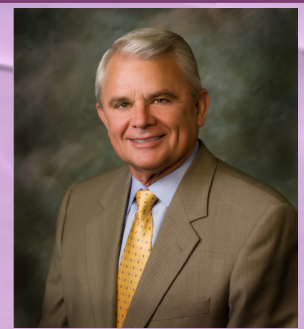

LSUHSC dental students Making Impressions

Thirty-five dental students, faculty and residents participated in a volunteer outreach event of the Remote Area Medical Volunteer Corps last weekend.

The LSUHSC team performed 151 extractions, 99 fillings, and a number of pulpotomies. They worked with x-ray units, and assisted each other, dentists and



surgeons. The LSUHSC team worked two days of the 3-day event for a total

of 281+ hours volunteered. Founded in 1985, Remote Area Medical® is a publicly supported all-volunteer charitable organization. Volunteer doctors, nurses, pilots, veterinarians and support workers participate in expeditions (at



their own expense) in some of the world's most exciting places. Medical supplies, medicines, facilities and vehicles are donated.
