## Andrieu named Alumna of the Year

Dr. Sandra Andrieu, Dental School Associate Dean for Academic Affairs, has been named



Alumna of the Year by the LSUHSC School of Dentistry.

The Alumna of the Year award honors her innovation in reshaping the DDS and Dental Hygiene curricula in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina as well as her national leadership as President of the American Dental Education Association (ADEA) which has a membership of 16,000 educators and students. Dr. Andrieu's efforts as Chair of the Council of Dental Accreditation Self-Study were also instrumental to a most successful outcome.
