

- How can we let the students know what we have?





#### KEEPING UP - INSTRUCTOR CHALLENGES


- How has the curriculum changed?






































# TEXTBOOKS AT LSUHSC-NO

## PRINT RESERVES

- Collection of course-related and high-use items
- Both Ische and Dental libraries
- Located behind the circulation desks
  - Library staff available to assist
  - In-library use
  - Overnight checkout may be available
    - \$1.00/hour overdue fee for late returns
  - Extended checkout for faculty by request
  - "Personal Reserves"



# TEXTBOOKS AT LSUHSC-NO

## ONLINE BOOKS - EBOOKS

- Online resources examples:
  - ClinicalKey
  - AccessMedicine
  - LWW Health Library
  - EBSCO eBooks
- Access models:
  - Subscriptions
  - Perpetual Access Purchases
- Access:
  - 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, on and off campus
  - For LSUHSC-NO faculty, students, staff only

- Number of users allowed:
  - Single user
  - Multi-user
  - Unlimited
- Multiple platforms
- Personalized accounts
- Limitations
  - Read online
  - PDF viewing vs eBook readers
  - Copy and paste
  - Limits on printing per session
  - Not available as a download


## COURSE RESERVES DATABASE

- What it is:
  - Part of our library catalog
  - Database of courses with library textbook information including both online and print textbooks
- What it isn't:
  - Does not include copies of articles or chapters (aka eReserves)



## COURSE RESERVES DATABASE

- How do we update it?
  - Textbook requests from students
  - Textbook and course information from instructors
  - Course information received from the Registrar
  - Textbook and course information received through Louisiana Board of Regents Act 125 Textbook Adoption Data Reporting Program (since Fall 2021)
    - Managed by LOUIS: Louisiana Library Network
    - Coordinated on campus by VCAA and the Registrar

## LOUISIANA BOARD OF REGENTS (BOR) DATA


- Registrar sends each school the BOR request for textbook data
- Instructors given the opportunity to provide and update textbook information
- Library reviews and edits the data
- Registrar uploads the data to the BOR
- LOUIS analyzes data for all higher education institutions
- LOUIS sends each library an analysis of the data to identify
  - Books that libraries already own
  - Books that can be purchased online
- LOUIS funding if available
- Library funding



## LOUISIANA BOARD OF REGENTS (BOR) DATA

- Search the library catalog to identify our holdings (what we have and don't have)
- Review titles and resources to identify what we can obtain
  - Order what we can
    - Online
      - Licensing
    - Print
  - Receive
  - Process
  - Catalog
  - Update spreadsheets
  - Update Course Reserves
