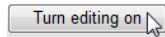


Moodle: How To Create Course Content

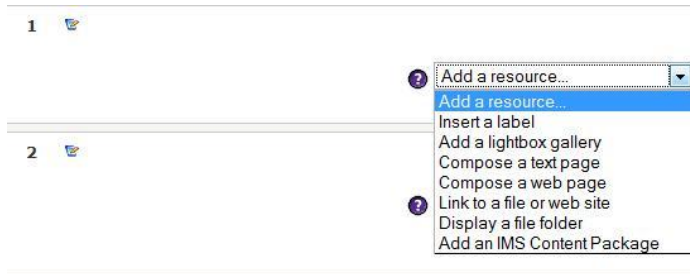

Creating a Resource

1. Login to Moodle and select the course.
2. At the **Course Outline** screen. Turn editing on by clicking on the button marked **Turn Editing On**.



3. Select a week to put the created content in. Then, select a resource from the drop down list labeled **Add a resource...**

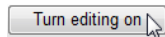

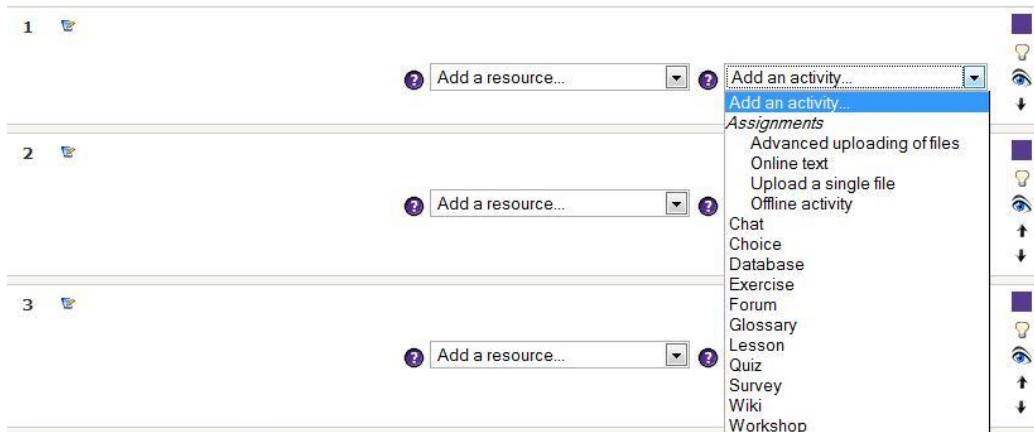

Creating an Activity

1. Login to Moodle and select the course.
