- Development of IT infrastructural library
- IT office hours: 1 hour presentations by IT department on 3rd Thursday of every month. These will be in MEB seminar room 3; LSUSD room number will be announced closer to dates of presentations. These sessions are accessible by Zoom.
- MYLSUHSC page: shortcuts to useful links
- Zoom is available to LSUHSC for online meetings. Meetings can be recorded and stored in cloud. Users are encouraged to backup meetings from cloud. IT website has information on how to use Zoom
- Website redesigning: all schools represented on the committee. Timeline to complete website redesigning 1 year
 - There are 3 subcommittees:
 - Content management system: timeline 1 month
 - Redesign- RFP to use commercial designer timeline 3 months
 - Policy committee: maintain uniform, unified and updated website
 - The process will need to be repeated approximately every 4 years
- Email archive: a vendor is needed to convert emails to Office 365. Timeline for this is ~1 year
- IT-related items which will be implemented for LSUHSC:
 - Drive encryption to prevent data breaches
 - Multifactor authentication to sign-in
 - Mobile application management (cell phones and tablets that use LSUHSC email/ software)
- Digital signage updates:
