Reports from Assemblies

Allied Health – met with new Interim Dean on 9/14/22 to discuss state of SOAH, everyone appreciates "open door" policy. Established a FA bylaws revision committee, Senator Norman asked if there a "formula" to determine % effort for faculty members—it was suggested that business managers/department chairs would be best able to assist

Dentistry – Drs. Lallier & Rosebush are new Senators, start in November, numerous construction/repairs occurring at the SOD in progress, new Dean starts Jan 1st. SOD recently held Alumni day, new Dean attended the function.

Graduate Studies – presentation by Omsbud, Dr. Brochu, GS workshop on conflict resolution with him October 12th, grad students doing well. GS Research Day, Nov 10th, reception/picnic on Friday, Nov 11th. SGA-sent out survey to GS, students report that they are low on funds

Medicine – discussion about move to CALS delayed due to sprinklers, parking in Roman garage due to move; Katherine Diodene was promoted to Assoc Dean for Financial Affairs; discussion of upcoming move from MEB to research space in CSRB

Nursing – Offsite instructional teaching-leading to diversifying in LA; classes are being held in Shreveport & Alexandria

Library – new look for discovery service for A-Z database, better looking, better function.

Senator Brisco reminded the Senate about the state association of faculty senates that meets at LSU-A on a quarterly basis (haven't met since 2020), representatives from all the colleges and professional schools, usually Saturday 10am-3pm, discuss education, salary compression, etc.

Senator Xu asked whether the current student housing would continue to be available? Yes. New student housing is via Foundation, not actually run by LSUHSC as student housing. It was asked if postdocs allowed to live in student housing. President Crabtree will investigate.
