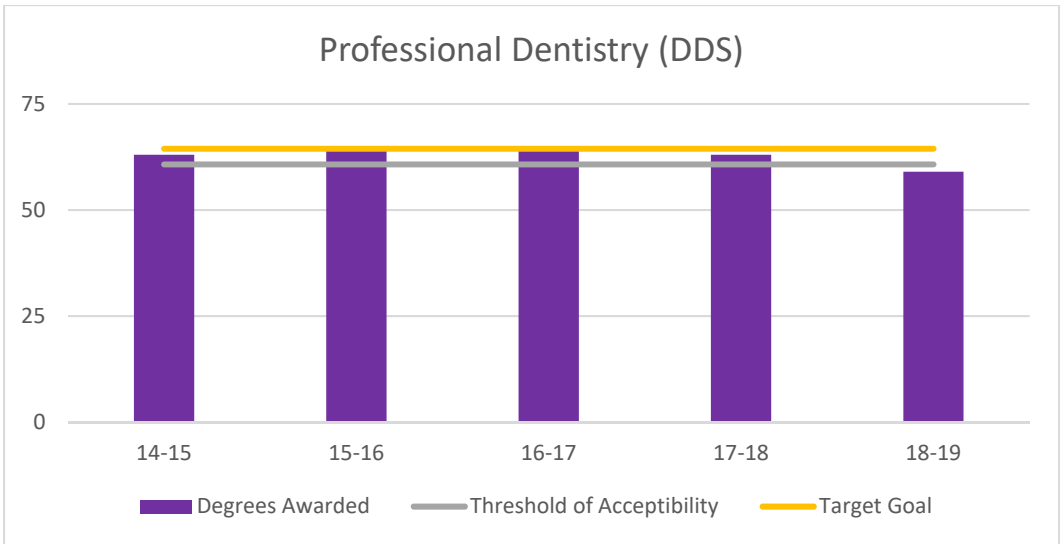

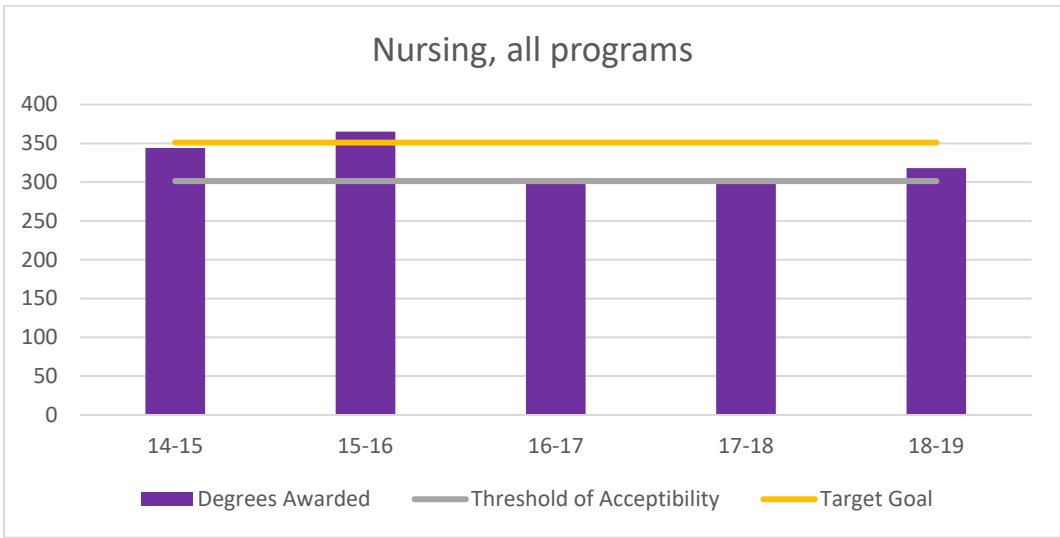


Note: Prior to academic year 2015-16, the School of Nursing (SON) and the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs oversaw a significant review and revision of the degrees offered in the SON. This review resulted in a number of master’s degree programs being eliminated and replaced by more advanced doctoral degree programs. This resulted in a reduced number of master’s degrees awarded overall, as evidenced in the data chart above.

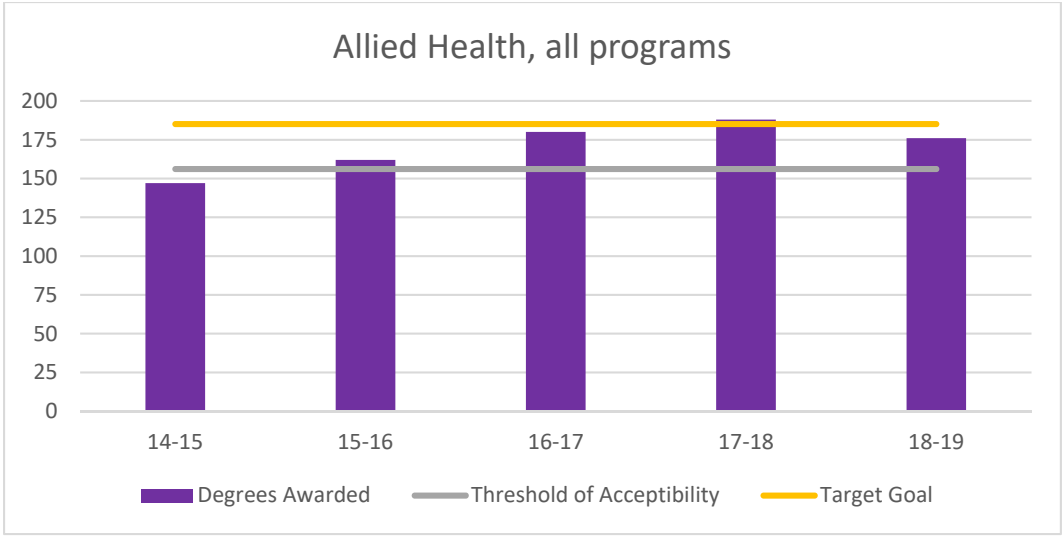




Note: The drop in Dentistry (DDS) degrees awarded in academic year 18-19 was due to students not satisfactorily completing courses in their third year of dental school. As this was the first decline in a number of years, it is not clear whether this decrease was isolated to that one class or the start of a downward trend. SOD administrators are monitoring the data to ensure appropriate action can be taken, should it be required.



Note: As mentioned above, in AY 2015-16 the School of Nursing replaced a number of master's degree programs with doctoral degree programs. The longer course of study to completion for these programs resulted in a temporary drop in total degrees awarded in the SON.



Note: The Physician Assistant Studies program in the School of Allied Health Professions began in academic year 13-14, with the first class graduating in 15-16. This accounts for the lower number of degrees awarded in 14-15 and the sustained increase thereafter.

This data is disaggregated by race/ethnicity for the same academic years.
